### How to configure *eduroam* (WIRELESS network) in Linux

The simplest way to connect to **eduroam** over wireless is by using the **Network Manager applet** which is now available in most Linux distributions.

Click on the applet and select **Connect to Other Wireless Network**.

Fill in the details as shown in the screen shot opposite replacing the Identity and Password fields with

Identity: eft09

Password: pionupsilon

Click the **Connect** button to connect to the eduroam network.
