Early Stage Researcher (ESR) in Theoretical Particle Physics

Within **FLAVIAnet** [http:/ific.uv.es/flavianet], the European Research Training Network devoted to flavour physics, an ESR position for a period of one year will be available at the University of Vienna.

The position is open for researchers in the first four years (full-time equivalent) of their research activity, including the period of research training, since gaining a diploma giving access to doctoral studies (the degree must entitle the holder to embark on doctoral studies, without having to acquire any further qualifications) and who have not yet obtained a doctoral degree. Researchers must be nationals of a state other than that of the host organisation. Candidates shall fulfil these requirements at the starting date of the ESR contract.
